

IXL's SmartScore is a special scoring system that gives you the best possible information on a student's true understanding of a skill. Use the SmartScore to set goals for your students and keep them motivated.

SETTING SMARTSCORE GOALS

- The IXL SmartScore ranges from 0-100 but is *not* a percentage score. It takes into account several factors, including questions answered correctly and incorrectly, question difficulty, recent answers, and consistency.
- As the SmartScore goes up and down, questions become harder or easier, which ensures students are engaged at the perfect level!

Best practice:

- When introducing a concept, set a SmartScore goal of 80 (proficiency) or 90 (excellence) for your students. If you have students who are ready for an extra challenge, have them strive for mastery (100)!
