




# IXL for personalized test prep with IXL StudyWise

IXL's personalized study plans guide students to the exact skills that will help them grow the most, based on their results from assessments such as the SAT®, ACT®, PreACT, NWEA MAP®, i-Ready Diagnostic, Star, FastBridge, and more.

Based on a student's current test scores, IXL's StudyWise tool creates a precise, customized list of skills they are ready to learn. At any time, study plans can be updated to get targeted next steps for continued progress. IXL's personalized study plans provide teachers with a powerful way to streamline and tailor test preparation for each individual student.

## Steps to successful implementation



### 1 Upload test scores

Navigate to the [StudyWise page](#) from the Learning tab to identify the study plan(s) you'd like your teachers to use in their classrooms.

For the desired study plans, select the "View guide" button to review instructions for uploading students' scores from a previous test or practice test to produce study plans all at once.



### 2 Get instant, individualized plans

Once created, personalized study plans will be automatically available on the StudyWise page, as well as students' and teachers' dashboards.

**Note:** Teachers and students can generate other study plans, though they do not have the ability to bulk upload scores.





If students do not have previous or practice test scores to enter for a personalized plan, they can utilize IXL's standard test prep skill plans in the meantime.



Students can simply navigate to the [Test prep](#) page, select the skill plan they would like to practice, and choose the targeted score range to view and begin working on the corresponding IXL skills.

### 3 Help students study smarter


While students begin working on their targeted practice, set concrete goals for IXL usage with your teachers. To maximize IXL's impact, we recommend students work on skills until they reach proficiency (a SmartScore of 80).

Research shows students perform better on state assessments when they reach proficiency in at least [two skills per week](#).

### 4 Encourage teachers to monitor student progress

Encourage teachers to use the [Student Score Chart](#) to view an individual student's progress on recommended skills. This report can be used with students to discuss their progress and can be printed out for parents. Students can also access this report from their Student Analytics.

**Tip for teachers:** Teachers can assign skills directly from a student's study plan to help them prioritize skills by clicking on the star icon next to a skill.



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
