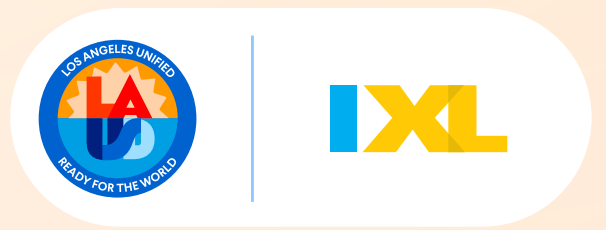


Tips for success



Work to a SmartScore of 80

- For each IXL skill, your child should work to a SmartScore of 80, which is considered proficiency.
- This assures that they have a really good grasp on the skill. If your child achieves proficiency and is ready for a challenge, they can always strive for mastery—a SmartScore of 100!

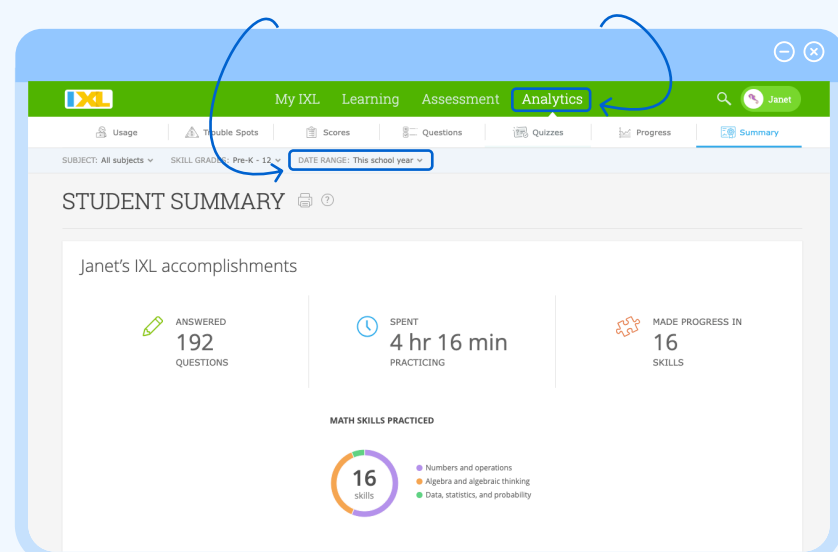
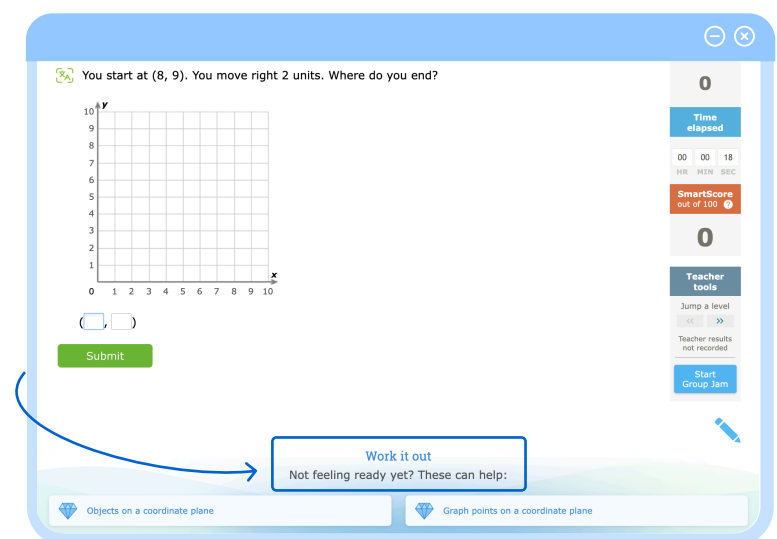


In-the-moment support

- IXL provides built-in tools to enable students to learn independently.
- This includes Learn with an example, audio support, Spanish language support, video tutorials for key math and language arts skills, and immediate feedback with step-by-step explanations.

Reinforce key concepts before moving forward

- If you notice your child is feeling stuck while working on a skill, they don't have to stay stuck—support is just a click away.
- They can use the in-skill recommendations at the bottom of the page under “Work it out” to work on foundational concepts. Then when they are feeling ready, they can tackle the original skill they were working on!



Track your child's progress

- See how your child is progressing and where you can help them grow. Navigate to Analytics to open the Student Summary report.
- You can change the date range to filter for your child's summer progress. You'll see all their recent accomplishments, which skills they need additional help on, and ways that you can provide extra support with IXL.
