

Clever SSO for IXL

If your school or district has set up an auto-rostering using Clever, students, teachers and administrators can use their Clever accounts to sign in to IXL. Enabling SSO can be done in just a few clicks and signing in to IXL using Clever is simple.

Setup

To enable single sign-on using Clever, follow the steps below:

1. Confirm that you have an auto-rostering integration set up with IXL using Clever as your rostering method.
2. Open the “Integrations” tab in the “Account Management” section of IXL and scroll to the “Single sign-on” section.
3. Click the “Set up SSO integration” button and select “Clever” as the SSO method.
4. Once you have made your selection, click “Begin setup”. This will enable your SSO integration with Clever.

Accessing IXL using Clever SSO

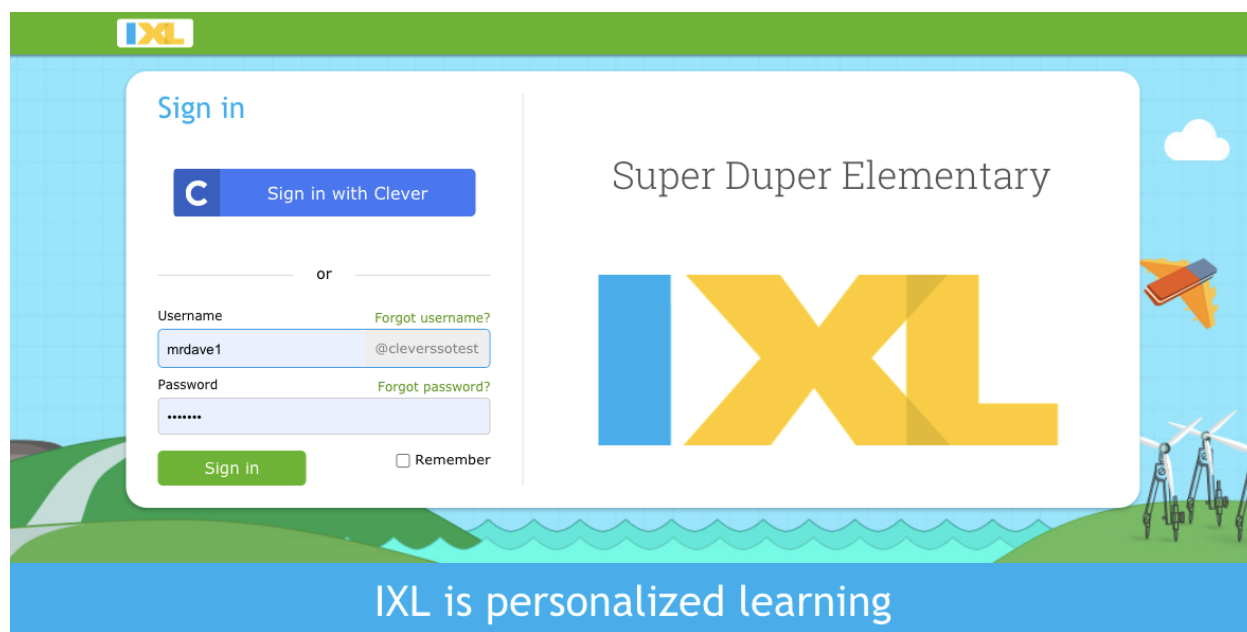
Students, teachers, and admins can access IXL using their Clever credentials from your IXL custom sign-in page or from their Clever portal.

IXL custom sign-in page

Your account has its own custom sign-in page. This is where you will find the “Sign in with Clever” button. You can find a link to this page in the “Account Management” section of IXL on the “Integrations” tab. You can also find it on the “Settings” tab where you can customize the logo and text on the page.

Follow these steps to sign in to IXL:

1. Make sure you are signed in to your Clever account.
2. Navigate to your account’s custom sign-in page.
3. Click the “Sign in with Clever” button at the top of the page. You will be taken to IXL and signed in to your account.



Clever Portal

Students, teachers, and administrators can also access IXL directly from the Clever Portal by clicking the IXL tile. As long as they have a valid IXL account, they will be taken directly to IXL and signed in automatically. If there are any issues, they will be taken to the custom sign-in page where they can sign in using their IXL username and password.
