

Using IXL's Google Classroom Add-on

IXL is personalized learning. With a comprehensive K-12 curriculum, individualized guidance, and real-time analytics, IXL meets the unique needs of each learner. The IXL Learning Google Classroom Add-on brings all of this directly into Google Classroom by supporting the most important workflows that teachers and students face on a daily basis.

Assigning an IXL Activity

Whether it is practicing one of the thousands of IXL skills or keeping levels up to date using the Real-Time Diagnostic, IXL's Activity Selector gives teachers everything they need. It supports filtering by subject and grade level, browsing by standard or textbook alignments, and smart searching of the entire skill catalog.

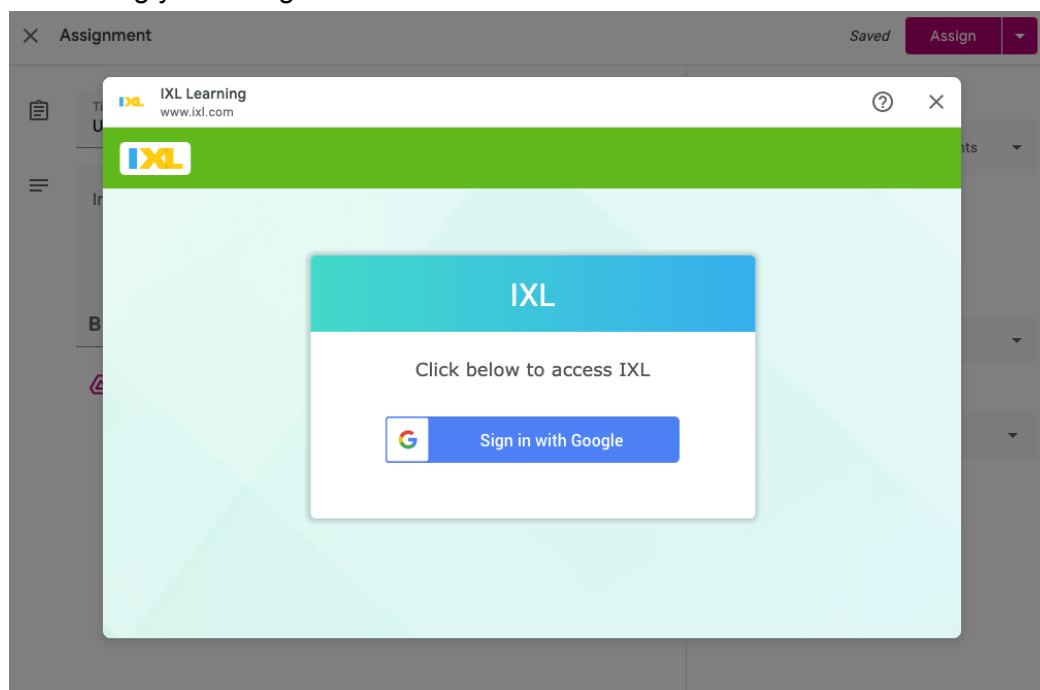
How to use the Activity Selector:

1. Create a new assignment in Classroom and click the "Add-ons" button
2. Select "IXL Learning" from the list of options

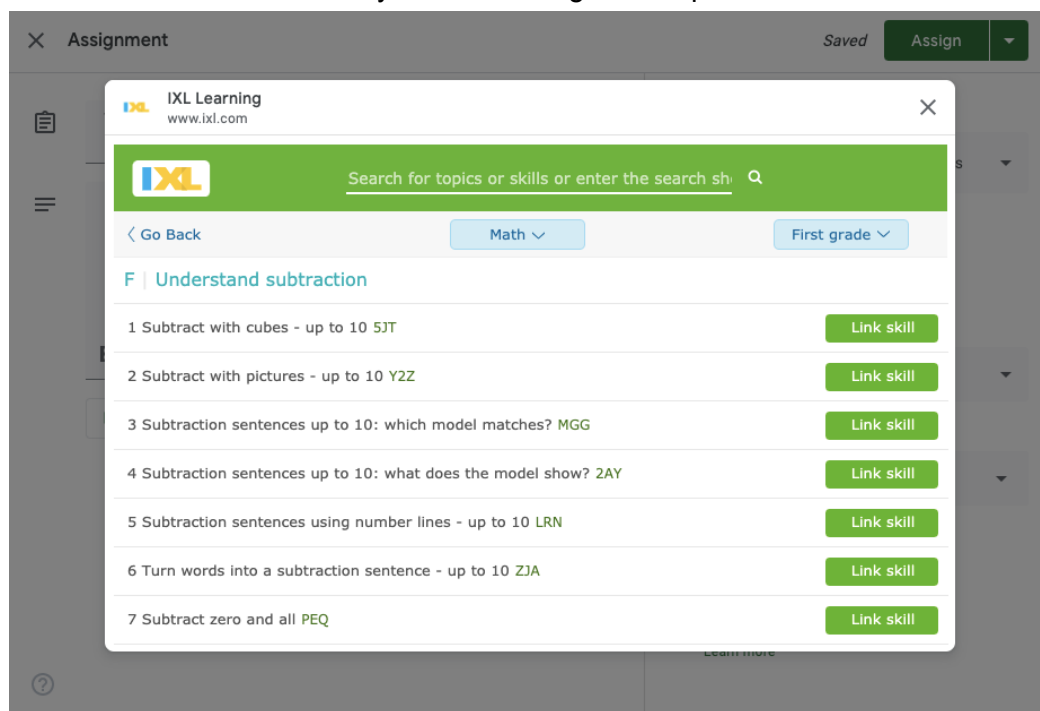
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3. Authenticate using your Google account



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4. Identify the activity you would like your students to work on through browsing or by using the search menu. You can search by name or using the unique skill code.



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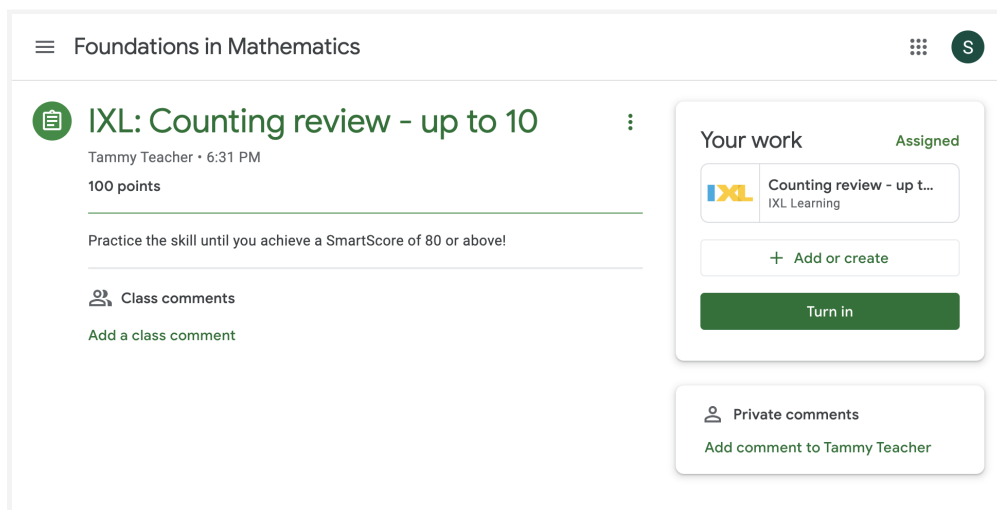
5. Once you find the activity you want, click the green “Link” button.

Launching an IXL Activity

Students can view assigned IXL activities in Classroom and launch into IXL to fulfill the assignment without having to use separate IXL credentials. They can also leverage all of IXL's additional resources including scaffolding, tutorials, and more.

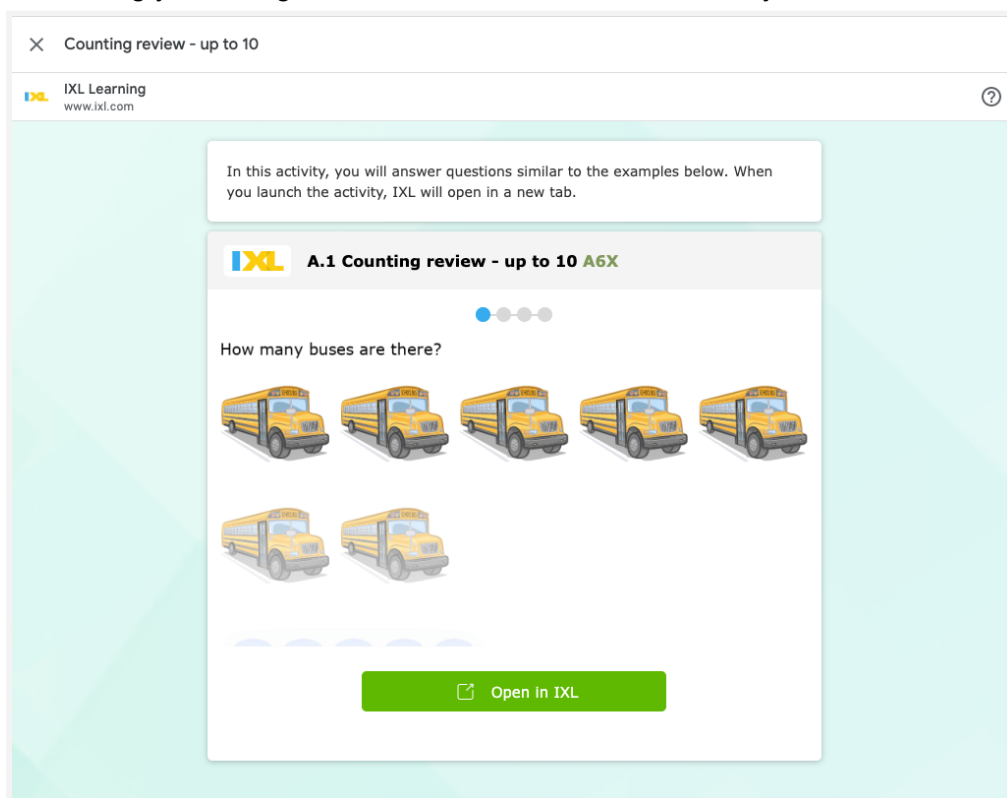
To launch an IXL activity:

1. Open the assignment and click on the attachment with the blue and yellow "IXL" logo.




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2. Authenticate using your Google Account and launch the IXL activity




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3. Complete your assignment on IXL according to the directions provided by your teacher

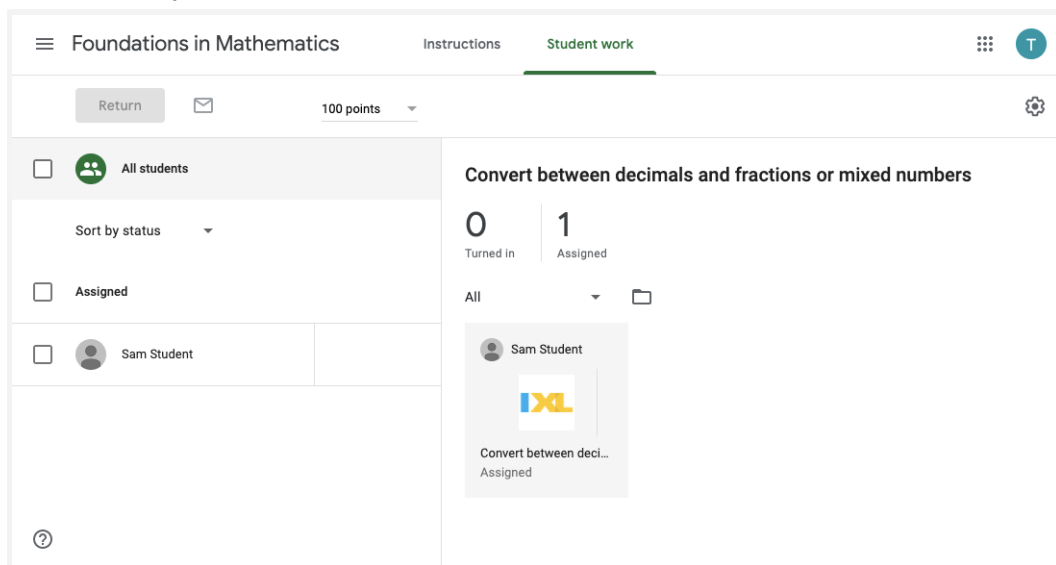
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Grading an IXL Activity

While IXL is mastery-based, many educators choose to grade assignments based on achieving a minimum SmartScore, answering a given number of questions, or practicing for a specified time period. However you grade, IXL's Activity Evaluator provides you with the relevant information you need to evaluate a student's performance.

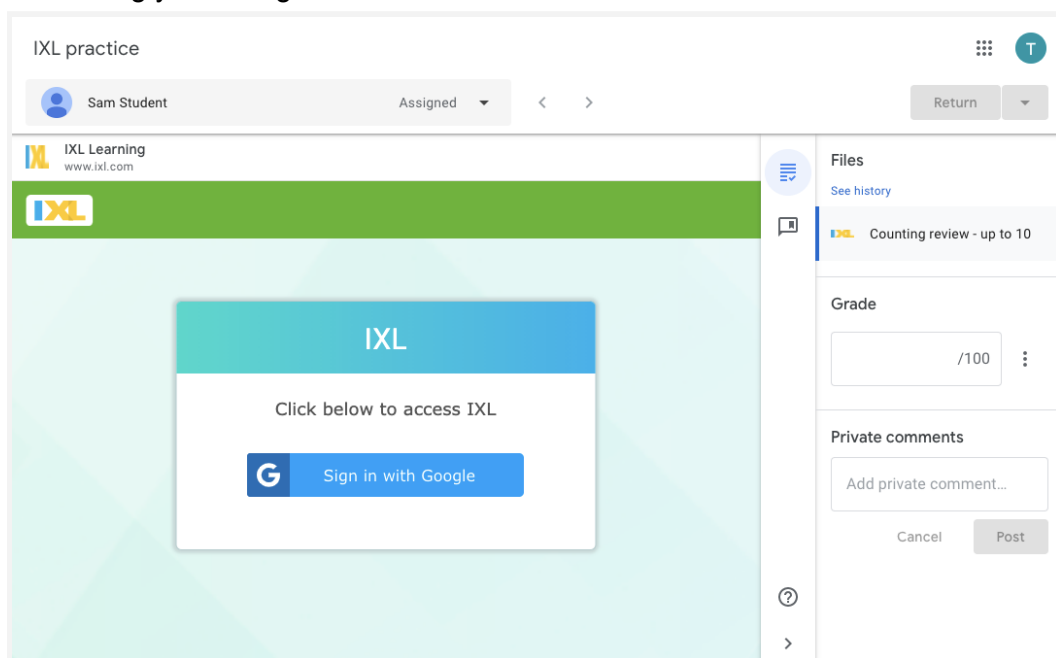
To grade an assignment:

1. Find the relevant assignment in the "Grades" tab
2. Click on the student you wish to evaluate



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3. Authenticate using your Google account



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4. Review the student's practice data to see how well they completed the assignment. You may use progress toward a target SmartScore like 80, a certain amount of time practiced, a minimum number of questions answered, or a combination of factors. If you need to dig deeper, click "See practice details" to open the Question Log report on IXL.
