Day 4	See what I mean?	Determine the meaning of domain-specific words with pictures (D8L) Determine the meaning of idioms from context: set 1 (8ML)
Day 5	Blast from the past	Read historical fiction with illustrations (GCP) Activity: Choose a time in history to research. Create a comic showing what life was like during this time.
Day 6	Sensing a pattern	Word pattern analogies (WWV) Label the rhyme scheme (PG7)



Day 7	Off the wall	Pick two skills from your Recommendations wall to practice!
Day 8	A world of my own	Read fantasy with illustrations (U9D) Use possessive pronouns (L6N)
Day 9	In my humble opinion	Compare and contrast points of view (GV8) Identify an author's statement of opinion (RAE)
Day 10	Places and poems	Read poetry (PCM) Activity: Choose a place you love to visit. Write a poem about the things you see, hear, taste, taste, touch, and smell when you're there.
Day 11	Out of order	Order the words to create a sentence (RQP) Determine the order of events in informational texts (CQA)
Day 12	Pause for paws	Commas with compound and complex sentences (QM9) Read passages about animals (L9D)
Day 13	The choice is yours	Pick two "Grammar and mechanics" skills to practice!
Day 14	Pretty as a picture	Similes and metaphors with pictures (9TK) Read passages about art, music, and traditions (WST)

Day 15	Mix things up	Create varied sentences based on models (UBL) <hr/> Activity: Write a story about a town where people behave in unexpected ways. Be sure to use many different styles and types of sentences.
Day 16	Home run	Read passages about sports and hobbies (GDH) <hr/> Is it a complete sentence or a run-on? (6XL)
Day 17	Which witch?	Homophones with pictures (7ZU) <hr/> Multiple-meaning words with pictures (QQU)
Day 18	Challenge accepted!	Pick a challenge from your awards page and try to earn it!
Day 19	Come together	Select the members of a group (FRR) <hr/> Sort words with shared prefixes and suffixes by meaning (55H)
Day 20	Make a change	Match problems with their solutions (XJG) <hr/> Activity: What is one thing people could do to make the world a better place? Make a poster persuading people to take this action!
